## Shun Lee Catholic Secondary School

There was bright sunshine as the school flag was raised at Hammer Hill Sports Ground, marking the beginning of the sports meet held on January 12 and 14.

Boys' Grade A team of Wisdom House completed the race in 53.09 seconds.

In addition, the inter-house relays involving the teachers were impressive as they showed off hidden potential.
